

The Spiritual Woman of Revelation 12:4. Part 3: "This Child is set for the fall and rising Again"

The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which <u>a woman</u> took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened. Matt 13:33.

Introduction:

Part 3, of our series "The Spiritual Woman of Revelation 12:4," we basically have four things to accomplish. One to illuminate the growth and development of the Lost Found Nation of Islam and its effects on the entire Black population in America, under the presence of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad.

An image is used from the "August/September 1979 edition of African Mirror Magazine," which shows the progress of the Lost Found Nation of Islam.

Secondly, in light of the development of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, told us it would fall. Why did the Nation have to fall? What did he



know that we didn't know? And where did he get the knowledge from? Were there any lessons for us to learn? We will attempt to answer these questions.

Thirdly, we will prove with the use of the Scriptures coupled with his actual history, that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, can <u>only</u> be the person that fulfills the prophecy of St Luke 2:34.

And lastly, we will give a few observations for readers to consider.

A Lump of Flesh

In our view many have not delved deeply into the fact that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, foretold of the "fall' of the Lost Found Nation of Islam. Others we feel for various reasons have render it of little importance. Considering the fact that within 2 years of his passing imminent signs of its collapsing began to emerge.

There is no question of the success of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, witnessed by the world and the emphasis placed on it. Yet at the same time Messenger Elijah Muhammad, knew that within a short period of time we would lose it all, convinced that we could not




hold it up. Was there something lacking in us? Was it a lesson we had not learned or need to? In light of it all clearly one can understand why just the thought of its falling brought Messenger Elijah Muhammad to tears. Crying and weeping, who does this but someone who's deeply in love with you?

In prior parts of this series we mentioned the accomplishments of the Muslim, and by extension Black people in America. The Lost Found Nation of Islam, was the collective hope of the people.

The graphic on the right gives us a wonderful illustration of the impact that the works and teachings of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, had upon Black people, not only in America but outside of America as well.

After the initial stages of his own learning curve, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, went about setting up Temples, in every major city throughout America. We know they were called Temples. But we feel they could very easily be called educational centers. For these were the places that black people were called to and encouraged to take on a different direction, teaching Black people away from the mental state and condition that the European Americans had placed them in.



From there he went on setting up formal schools of learning; to teaching better eating habits and physical heath; to developmental growth in business and manufacturing; good homes, good jobs and steady employment; national and international trade with other countries; leading directly and ultimately to laying a foundation for a people to sustain themselves in the necessities of life food, shelter and clothing.



These tangibles representing an **outward** expression of his work with Black people in America, in economics terms, had some estimating the value of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, anywhere between 85 million to a 150 million dollars or more. ¹

And, if the outward expression of Messenger Elijah Muhammad's teachings in the short course of 40 years, evidenced in tangible value to the tune of 150 million dollars or more. Then how much more valuable was the <u>intrinsic development of his teachings put inside black people?</u> Think about that!

Many phrases encapsulated in the teachings of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, were groomed into the nature of black people — "First Love Yourself," "Do for Self," "Accept Your own and Be Yourself," "I want for My Brother what I Want for Myself," "The Economic Blueprint," "How We Can Unite," "How to Eat to Live," "Do Good," "Be Right," "Speak the Truth," "My Word is my Bond," "Good homes and Friendship in all Walks of Life." ²

These teachings developed internally in black people caused a great reawakening of the spirit of life and productivity, which was heretofore dead in us having suffered a spiritual death in the tomb of America.

The physical value is one thing. But the spiritual value of the teaching of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and the Lost Found Nation of Islam, stands immeasurable. Master Fard Muhammad's, aim and purpose was to get to us, a downtrodden and unproductive people to give us a life renewed, through one from among us called a Messenger. And that one was the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad. Over the course of his time with us Messenger Elijah Muhammad, was in pursuit of giving birth to a Nation and did. But what happened?

The Fall

With tears in his eyes the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, in several places during his lifetime spoke about the "fall and rising" again of the Lost Found Nation of Islam. Looking in retrospect, in economic terms, the fall of the Nation, will probably be framed as the most cataclysmic occurrence that could've happened to Black people in America. It certainly was an abrupt and drastic change.

Messenger Elijah Muhammad, often warned us to be prepared for the day of want and need. It is 2019, and most wealth indicators points to the dire economic condition of Black people in America, and the growing wealth gap between whites and blacks in this country. We can only imagine what is might look like today if it was left alone to prosper and grow? However, it wasn't to be and we have arrived at a different phase of our total resurrection.

From its meteoric like rising to within 2 year after the death of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, when signs of its imminent decline began to emerge. The Lost Found Nation of Islam, was no more. It's clear today that the full understanding of what occurred, its impact, and what has gone on since then have not been fully understood. The Messenger, did not speak idle words nor did he do unnecessary things.

There are those who have made their way into the ranks of some faction of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, who were not even born at the time of the fall, who today have no contextual bases to the 'why' of his forecast, as devastating as it was.

Nor do they understand the conditions under which it fell, nor the process of its rising again. We believe we have not properly navigated through this moment, which lends itself towards our inability to come back collectivity, to the next stage of what is intended for us to do. In our view it represents a blind spot for a lot of people.

The Messenger, said to us the importance that Scientist placed on one word in a debate. In the debate for our salvation, is his words any less important? Since he is the Messenger, of the people should not his words cast the final verdict on everything pertaining thereto? We have his words of the fall and rising again of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, expressed privately to some and publicly to others. In light of the devastating results of his forecast and given the value of his words and teachings, then surely, they require more than a cursory glance as some seem to give them.

We believe, his words concerning the fall and rise carries a greater meaning, which makes necessary an earnest attempt to understand them in context to when he gave them, what took place afterwards, and where we are today and align our thinking with his.

The Knowledge of the Fall

When Messenger Elijah Muhammad, spoke of the fall no one actually believed him while standing there looking at the successful achievements of the Lost Found Nation of Islam. Yet he spoke it. The knowledge of the fall - was it of his own mind and something he made up? Or, was it his Teacher, Master Fard Muhammad, you taught him what would take place with us? Certainly, none of us knew enough of anything to prevent it from falling. And an argument can be made, that perhaps Wallace, his son, didn't actually realize at first, what he was doing in the process of the fall of the Lost Found Nation of Islam?

So, let us look at how Messenger Elijah Muhammad, came by these words, when, and from whom, by his own account?

We have to reason that before he met Master Fard Muhammad, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, was not completely unlearned in the scriptures and had some understanding



of it. Like many of us, he too came up in the church and Christianity. As a child his aspirations was to be a Baptist preacher just like his father. And in his experiences and Biblical learning at that stage of his life, he had learned enough about the Bible, that upon seeing Master Fard Muhammad, was able to recognize him to be the man that was supposed to be here in America.

Yet we can also understand the fact that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, in the early stages of his Messengership, did not have a thorough and complete understanding of the Bible nor all of its prophecies.

Messenger Elijah Muhammad, writing on the Days of Allah, taught that "the Days of Allah, are the fulfillment of the predictions of the prophets of Allah," coming to past. MTTBMIA, page 23.3

He also stressed the importance of putting predictions where they belong and not try to fit them where they do not belong, he states, "Let us remember that we must understand the truth of prophecy, the sayings of the Holy Qur'an and Bible on this subject, and then place them where they belong and not try to fit them in some place where they do not belong." MTTBMIA, page 252.

He taught this lesson to his Ministers, with respect to his prophetical roles, he states "You are to show proof that compares with predictions." (March 11, 1965, Letter to Ministers) You do understand when he says predictions, he means prophecy? Then the same rule of prophecy also applies to God. ⁴

In other words, these predictions should not be taken lightly and we are cautioned to not put them in the wrong places trying to fit them in where they do not belong. He told us these things (prophecies) are put there to shed light, give guidance and deepen our understanding of the time in which we live, especially, if we are to be saved from the impeding destruction of the enemies of Allah. One of the valued lessons for us to learned is understanding prophecy and putting it in in its proper place.

Tampering with Prophecy

The white race dictionary's gives a very tricky definition of prophecy, while acknowledging it as "predictions.

"Prophecy" (noun)

- prediction, forecast, prognostication, prognosis, divination, augury.
- divination, fortune-telling, crystal gazing, second sight, prognostication, soothsaying.

As you can see in the second part, they seem to give it as something non divine or perhaps guessing.⁵ (*New Oxford Am Dict.*)

But for our purposes let us imagine a person that sets in motion a series of events to occur 5, 10, 100, or 400 years in the future at which time it all comes to past as predicted. This tells us several things.

- 1. The power of the 'mind' of the individual to set something in motion and 'see' that far into the future when it is scheduled to happen.
- 2. That although they may not be around at the time the events come to past, yet they are confident enough to project their 'word' that far futuristically.
- 3. If in the fact that the events do happen as was projected, it verifies and evidences or brings to reality their 'spoken word.'
- 4. If in the fact that the events happen as was projected down through time, is verification that 'they' existed beforehand.

This seems to be what our lessons teach us concerning authoring Scriptures. That we wrote events coming down the road to be fulfilled and they happened just as we wrote it. For, that which man writes is fulfilled by man. And nothing besides another Man can prevent it or alter it from happening. Which when you think about it actually proves that man is God. What do you think? We think it's a pretty good understanding of prophecy.

In this quote, in no uncertain terms Messenger Elijah Muhammad, makes clear to us from where he received his "understanding" of the prophecies and from whom. "There is nothing in the prophecies that God has not taught me the understanding of." (Our Savior has Arrived, page 195) If this be the case, and it is, then Master Fard Muhammad, gave him the knowledge of our fall and rising again.

Mary Receives the News

To prove this let us do a bit of history contextualization of what occurred in the life of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and then match it with Biblical prophecy, to determine whether or not we are fitting it where it belongs as is instructed of us to do.

Using the King James version of the Bible at the Book of St Luke, Chapter 2, verse 34, it reads.

"And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this *child* is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against;"

Now we already know that the Bible have been tampered with by the tricks and lies of the white race. The Messenger taught us that. But he also untangled many of the lies that the white race added to it. A prime example is Revelation 12:4, where he gives the correct understanding these scriptures, referring to himself and our people. Bringing the true understanding of these few scriptures alone literally destroy the false religious teachings of the Catholic Church. But that's for another paper down the road.

What we want to see is if the Bible, in St. Luke 2:34, is in congruent with Messenger Elijah Muhammad's actual life? If it is, then, it is confirmed as true.

We note that there are other translated 'version,' of the Bible which turns the phrase 'fall and rising,' to 'rising and fall.' For example, the Berean Study Bible reads, 'rise and fall,' yet the Berean Literal Bible, reads, 'the falling and rising.' However, most of the other versions are consistent using with the phrase, 'fall and rising again.' All of the translated versions are consistent with Mary, being told this about her child Jesus by a man named 'Simeon.' Simeon, is reported to be a devout and righteous man.

The elements under consideration are the presence of a man, (Simeon), with the information about the future of Mary's child. Secondly, Simeon shared it with Mary, the mother, not the child. Third, according to the story, Mary's baby, Jesus, was in the early stage of infancy.

Comparing the elements of the above scripture does it match the life of Messenger Elijah Muhammad? Yes, it does!

First, we have it that Master Fard Muhammad, a man from Mecca, Arabia, came into America, and taught his Messenger, Elijah Muhammad. We have it from the Messenger, that this is the same Man from whom he received his understanding of prophecy. He did publish the message that he, the Last Apostle of Allah, is the Spiritual Woman of Revelation 12:4, impregnated with a child (nation) who was not ready to be delivered (go to their own). MTTBMIA, page 127.

He identified the Woman of Revelation 12:4, to be the woman, Mary. And as late as 1974, at a place he's pointing out the tricks of the white race deceiving black folk about certain characters including Mary, he stated, "This is Mary," in reference to himself.⁸ (OSHA, page 34) These are all facts.

More importantly, St Luke, almost give us the Messenger exact words concerning the future of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, knowledge not a single one of us knew or had. Did the fall occur? Yes, we are living witnesses that is did. And, today we see the Lost Found Nation of Islam on the rise again, slowly, but steadily, all of which matches the elements of St Luke 2:34.9

Is all this a coincidence? We think not. There are not any events in a historical sense which perfectly match the prophecy of St Luke 2:34, as does the Coming of Master Fard Muhammad, the life of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and we, the so-called Negroes as we were called.

Some sceptics may say, that Simeon is not the coming of God, as was Master Fard Muhammad, so how can Messenger Muhammad, fulfill St Luke 2:34? Keep in mind that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, taught us that the Son Man, Master Fard Muhammad, was referred to under many names in the Scriptures.

In addition, with appreciation to Prophet Muhammad's, work consider where in the Qur'anic writings, Mary, who "screened" herself was sent the spirit of Allah, in the form of a well-made "man." Is there any surprise that here again we have Mary, dealing with a holy man? (See HQ 19:17) It was not a spook that appeared before Mary, it was a man. What other form would we expect Allah, to appear in but a man?

The same is spoken in the scriptures about Simeon, reporting to be a devout and righteous man. What better spirit for a man to have or to practice in his life other than a righteous one? Looking through the eyes of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, it should be crystal clear that he saw righteous characteristics and more in his teacher, Master Fard Muhammad.

Thus, its concluded that the truth of St Luke 2:34, was fulfilled in the life of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and only him.

Lessons Learned

It may be challenging to pinpoint the exact moment in time that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, first uttered the words publicly or privately, of the fall and to whom. But all agree that the fall of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, was devastating to say the least, rippling affects which are still felt today. However, it was at the death of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, literally, when all hell broke loose.

The renowned men in the ranks were sat down and fell under the emerging leadership of Wallace D. Mohammed. The image of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and the God, Allah,

he represented to us was casted down before the people. Businesses and properties owned by the believers, built on the belief in Allah, as taught by Messenger Elijah Muhammad, was confiscated and disbursed. The schools were reassigned to an Orthodox Islamic curriculum. Temples was shutdown, the flag was put down. The FOI and MGT, was disbanded. What happened? What changed in the people? (followers)

Recall the times before, when Wallace went against his father. Did the majority 'believers' crumble or go astray or abandon their belief and followed Wallace? No. Why? Because the Messenger was there to hold them up. It was in his absence that the test came. What test? The test of whether God was man, or was a spirit god floating in space controlling the affairs of men.

For forty years, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, taught us that God is man and it was on that belief the foundation of Lost Found Nation of Islam, was born. This message was put out there before the world, and world saw the results of it as did we. It was his major message to us purposefully snatching us from the falsehood of white world Christian teachings. No matter what form the belief in a spirit god takes across any religious spectrum it is still Christianity.

With Wallace's emergence as leader over the people his major assault was against the concept that man is God, as taught by his father, that upon his death successfully reinstituted this false belief in a spirit-god once again. And, the moment we turned back into the filth of that thinking for salvation, all we erected crumbled to the ground – all of it. Why?

Because a spirit-god does not erect nations let alone hold one up. Wallace realized, and his disciples too will realize that a spirit god couldn't hold him up nor bring them salvation. But for the fall of the Lost Found Nation of Islam, how else were we to learn that man is God, then to lose everything we built?

In closing and to be sure. It was a man (in person) that came from the East, Mecca, Arabia, with information including the knowledge that the Black man is God, and up came the stood the people. Under the watchful eyes of his choice student, a man, a believer, on the strength of the belief that man is God, up came the signs of a Nation. We all beheld it.

In his death when all was lost, did a spirit-god arrived on the scene and dismantled the Lost Nation of Islam, or was it a man? It was (Wallace) a man, a disbeliever, who thought a spirit-god could lead and guide him and us. Even in his death, he too has learned a great lesson. It must be understood that men build nations and structures, organizational or otherwise, and it is men who tear them down.



And, if the Lost Found Nation of Islam, is to arise again then the expectation is that it be done by a man. On one man was it built, on another man it was tore down, yet on another man would it be erected again.

We like to pay requisite respect to the Honorable Silis Muhammad, the CEO of the Lost Found Nation of Islam/Afrodescendant Government, through whom we would not have the insight, to see things clearly out of obscurity. We recognize his courageous stance against all odds in August of 1977, to fight against and attack Wallace's spirit god belief, used to usurp the properties of the people. ¹⁰

As Simeon blessed Mary's child, we also recognize that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, Our Spiritual Mother, fashioned him as a blessing to our people.
