

The Spiritual Woman of Rev 12:4. Part 2: “*The Condition of the Children on the Coming of God*”

Introduction

In this paper our attempt is to contextualize the conditions that Black people lived under in America before the coming of Master Fard Muhammad, what took place when he made himself known, what followed, and his great contributions to the lives of all Black people. By providing specific references from the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, we feel would lend support to our observations.

Secondly, we dispel the erroneous notion that the child (American so-called Negroes) in reverse order is the Woman of Rev 12:4, who gives birth to Messenger Elijah Muhammad, incongruent to what he taught.



Understand first and foremost that black people in America were the target that Master Fard Muhammad, was aiming for and his purpose for coming into America. In realization of the knowledge that he was searching for and seeking to help a people who had been lost from their family ties. Master Fard Muhammad, traveled into different parts of the world studying and observing the cultural conditions of the people he encountered. Particularly those who had come in contact with the European civilization and their practice of colonization and the usage of slavery in the world.

We would be told, according to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, that Master Fard Muhammad could speak 16 languages and wrote 10 of them as well. How should we understand the value of him learning 16 languages and writing 10 of them? Its reasoned then that in those situations where he crossed paths with people of other cultures that they must've retained their mother's language and could speak it.

However, his observation of our condition in America, was that we were unable to speak our own language. For a people, its' mother's tongue or language of origin is the connective tissue of social, cultural and religious ties. It is the thing which allows communication and connection to one's family ties from generation to generation.

It's one thing when a person gets lost in a forest or on a dark road. Having a familiarity with the surrounding area in all likelihood they are still able to find their way home. However, when one has lost the ability to speak the language of his or her ancestry, they are no longer able to communicate with family.

Having our mother's language forcibly removed from us by the Caucasian race, severed us from our family ties, our place of origin, our customs, culture, social and religious ties. Due to this having happen to us we were a lost people cut off from the knowledge of self and kind.

From his vantage point his observation of us, Master Fard Muhammad, over the space of 20 years made the determination that we were the lost people that he had found. He immediately began the task to equipped us with a new learning and knowledge of self and kind that we were cut off from. Starting in Detroit, he began teaching us the knowledge of ourselves.

His raising up and teaching the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, to become his Messenger, was to provide black people in America, one of our own who had experienced American slavery, an experience which as a young boy in Cordell, Ga, he saw a black man lynched and hung from a tree.

Master Fard Muhammad, actions were deliberate to his intentions to help us and he gave the solution to his student to give to us first and then to others in the same condition around the world. He left afterwards feeling secure that his student understood the message and his task to deliver it. Since his finding the Lost-Found Nation of Islam, its aims and purposes from its inception have been to rejoin, reconnect or resurrect Black people in America, back to their own.

A Prophecy from God

Through Messenger Elijah Muhammad, we learned that we authored the Scriptures well in advance. He taught us that we are from the lineage or descendants of a man some 50,000 years ago. We also learned from him that Genesis 15:13-15, is not really the history of Caucasian Jews, allegedly enslaved in Egypt 4000 years ago, but rather a prophecy which we are fulfilling today, some of it. Notwithstanding the fact that we have yet to be physically separated from America and escape her destruction.

Genesis 15:13-14 it reads:

13. And he said unto Abram, know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; 14.

And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.¹

Messenger Elijah Muhammad, expounds, ***“According to the Bible's history made by Abraham, on receiving the prophecy of our enslavement in a strange land, and people, to serve for four hundred years...Beyond a shadow of doubt, this is the strange land, and the white race, a strange people to the original Indians and our fathers, who were brought here in 1555; four hundred and seven years ago, did not know either the people (white and Indian) nor the country. All were strangers...if this is not the answer to Abraham's prophecy, then you may tell me...we are the people that Abraham saw, and prophesied that would be lost and must be found.”*** (Separation is a Must, article Messenger Elijah Muhammad)²

Additionally, he said, ***“There are no historical records of a people being lost from each other for 400 years other than the so-called Negroes,”*** (MTTBMIA page 20)³

Let us understand that being victims of 400 years of slavery in America is our least common denominator and there should be no argument between us. With respect to being ‘afflicted,’ prior to Master Fard Muhammad’s entering America and making himself known history is replete with black people being victimized by white mob attacks where in many cases these mob attacks were joined by local, state and federal officials.

These incidents reported as race riots were in actuality flat out massacres that decimated whole Black communities. Prior to 1886, and from there right up to the massacre in Springfield, Illinois, in 1908, to the “Red Summer of 1919; to the destruction of Black Wall Street in Tulsa, Oklahoma in 1921; to Rosewood, in 1923: taking in account the history of both the Honorable Noble Drew Ali, and the deportation of the Honorable Marcus Mosiah Garvey. Black people in America have been under the constant assault of a vicious American Government and people ever since we’ve been here.

This was the condition of our people prior to Master Fard Muhammad, making himself known. We in America fulfill all of the criteria listed above to the letter confirming the teachings of Messenger Elijah Muhammad. Abraham is our forefather, who not only had a religious faith, but according to the scriptures he also had land, resources, and other riches which marked him as a very wealthy man. And our enslavement in America in the confines of a strangers reality would not only mean we were deprived of the knowledge of his religious faith, but also be without access to his land, wealth and other riches.

Messenger Elijah Muhammad, teaches us that we here in America are – **“The true descendants of Ishmael.”**⁴ Which means anyone born through Isaac lineage is our nephew. Messenger Elijah Muhammad, also told us, that God came from the sons of Esau (Eliphaz,) a son of Isaac. **(See Message to the Black Man in America)**

Abraham had sons, Ishmael and Isaac. Ishmael, is the oldest and he and his mother Hager by circumstances were outcasted. Not so with Isaac he stayed there in his father’s home. In the East it is a long time custom that the oldest is ‘first heir’ to the inheritance of the father. Surely Abraham had this knowledge as its read within the prophecy. But Ishmael is not there he was put out to go through an ordeal by way of his father, Abraham, until the day of return. All of Abraham’s offspring didn’t leave home or was put out and went into slavery. That was Ishmael’s lineage.

And, if one day the descendants of Ishmael were to returned home to his father’s house, would not they still be the same “heir’s” in line to inherit the wealth and property that his father possessed? Where is that land and wealth today? And, who have possession of these riches?⁵

Who of our family members were appointed custodianship to retain and keep safe these riches, lands and wealth intact that we could resume use of it on our return? And why have they not come forth and claimed us, their brethren assisting us to return home? Do they not know that the period of our enslavement, 400 years are up?

Does this sound familiar to you? It should because we have experienced the actual history of it just as we wrote it. And, nothing has come in between or altered what we wrote.

Some 400 hundred years ago, we went to sleep and died a spiritual death being put under a cruel ordeal, until the time or call for us to re-awaken or come back to spiritual life. When the time came, because it was God who put himself to sleep in the first place, then to re-awaken God or resurrect him from his spiritual grave, someone of equal or greater power would have to come to give life to him once again. Only a God can resurrect or give birth to another God. And, because the people of God needed to be born again a spiritual birth had to take place. We pointed that out in Part 1.

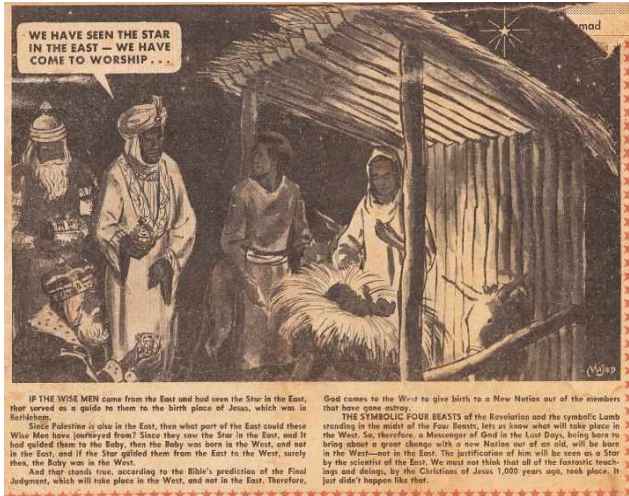
The person, worthy to receive God’s mind, God’s knowledge, the kind of mind that could conceive the reality of God in Man, was the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad.

Land and money are real property. While we won’t go into all of it here. However, please understand that our father’s land and wealth as an inheritance is ours because we are first heir’s to the promise. If we returned home it would be ours. However, that land, wealth

and riches are in the hands of some of our unrighteous family members who don't want you to have it.



They of our family holding claim to our identity and inheritance don't mind giving us "religion and rituals." It's the money, land, wealth and resources they wish to hold on too. They wish to hold on to it in the same way the Caucasian Jews, want to hold on to our spiritual identity and birthright by claiming they served in slavery for 400 years.

They are there in the East holding on to what belongs to you and I, but they don't want us to return to have it. However, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, said

otherwise. That we are the true descendants of Ishmael and must return home.

But, for the coming of Master Fard Muhammad, from Mecca, Arabia, we would have never known any of this. It should be clear why some orthodox Muslims don't want you to know the truth of the Last Messenger and yourselves, by keeping us deaf, dumb and blind, they can hold on to our heritage, wealth and property. These unrighteous one's and their Caucasian friends know this to be true.

Remember this. It was on the sighting of a particular star around the time of the birth of Jesus, that not only was the authorities on alert to harm the child, so too was some wise men "from the East," they were on the move seeking the whereabouts of the child. However, their interests were not in helping the child they had another thing in mind. Now you may understand why is was so important and necessary that the Woman, of Rev 12:4, had to protect her child. Her child had more than one enemy. More on this subject at a later time.

Dispelling the Notion that the Child (the people) were Impregnated to Give Birth

There are some who erroneously promote that the child (the people) was to be impregnated by Almighty God, Allah, that through them comes the spiritual birth of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, the Last Messenger of Allah, directly contradicting what he taught about himself. However, here we provide a full explanation from the Last Messenger describing the mental, spiritual, and religious death like state that black people were in having been deceived wholly by the false religious teachings of the white race.

"We have the emblem of Christianity as a cross, and a crucified man on it right?"

That is the emblem of Christianity, which means that the people who follow this religion will suffer persecution, they will suffer enslavement, they will suffer death under this particular religion.

They will be bound in the power of the white man hand and feet. They won't be able to move their hands for their use. They won't be able to use their feet to walk to that in which that they want to. Their steps will be limited. They are nailed to the cross of Christianity under the power of the white man. Their heads are (is) crowned with thorns, not literal thorns, but that particular ignorant knowledge of the truth, going through their brain cells, like a literal thorn being pricked into the brain. There you are, unable to think for self.

Christianity deprives you of that. That's the thorns in your head now. You are stabbed through the heart, you are unable to feel the wounds, you died with grief and sorrow under Christianity.⁶ Lecture: Christianity vs Islam: Nov 7, 1962, Philadelphia, Penn.

Thus, prior to 1930 and being a product of the above-mentioned conditions, and the surrounding environment as explained, totally dispels the notion that the child of the Woman, (the people) were in any condition to be used by God, Allah, as a conduit to give to birth to the Last Messenger of Allah as some suggest. In whole or in part it is a false teaching, which cannot be proven in prophecy or from the teachings we received. To be sure: Messenger Elijah Muhammad was not born of the spirit of God. Messenger Elijah Muhammad was taught directly by God, Himself, as was no other.

Truly understood and applied properly the revelation of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, being the Woman of Revelation 12:4, a prophet of God, lends a crushing blow to the whole phony façade of the white Christian order of Catholicism, because they constructed a false foundational teaching using Jesus and his mother Mary.

How should we understand the signs of Mary's Impregnation?

When America's Great Depression started, just months before Master Fard Muhammad, began to teach Black people in Detroit, Michigan, lasting from 1929 to 1939, it was the worst economic downturn in the industrialized world. While no group escaped the economic devastation of the Great Depression, few suffered more than black people in America, said to be "last hired, first fired," black people were the first to see hours and jobs cut, and experienced the highest unemployment rate during the 1930s. Since they were already relegated to lower-paying jobs, Black people had less of a financial cushion to fall back on when the economy collapsed.

Doing this time, the lives of Black people were affected for decades to come. Black unemployment rates doubled or tripled to that of whites. Before the Great Depression Black folk mainly held unskilled jobs and after the market crashed those jobs disappeared or were taken over by whites. According to Library of Congress records, the unemployment rates of Black people climbed to 50 percent.

In cities across the North, like Pittsburgh and Chicago jobless rates among Black people reached 50 percent. In Philadelphia and Detroit, it was as high as 60 percent, and some estimates had jobless rates higher in the South. Hundreds of thousands of Black sharecroppers fell into debt and was forced to joined what is termed as the Great Migration, moving from the rural South to the urban North. According to estimates nearly 1.5 million Black people or more moved from the South to cities in the North and West.

In 1934, Master Fard Muhammad, doing this time apparently making an impact upon the minds of Black people drew the attention of the authorities of Detroit, who placed him under arrest and ultimately ordered him out of the city. Where upon his arrival in Chicago he was arrested also by city authorities, according to the history given us by Messenger Elijah Muhammad. And shortly thereafter he tells us that Master Fard Muhammad departs for good.

At this point in time the Temple of Islam experienced small but steady growth, a Temple, where the people were taught and trained, a school to educate the young, and a large following of about 10,000 Black people.

In the same year Messenger Elijah Muhammad, took himself to the jail in Detroit after learning that the Michigan State Board of Education had arrested the Muslim Teachers of the School of Islam and the secretary of the Temple on false charges of contributing to the delinquency of minors. Although, the charges were dropped and the teachers freed. He was given 6 months' probation and ordered to put the Muslim children back in the public schools under Christian teachers, a thing he said he did not do, later on moving to Chicago in September of that year.

A Swelling

At the same time a rise in Black activism was occurring, organizing and mobilizing for economic opportunity and social and political rights. The "Don't Buy Where You Can't Work" boycotts;⁷ Mary McLeod Bethune organizing the National Council of

Negro Women, in 1935;⁸ and other Black organizations fighting for anti-lynching legislation, elimination of the poll tax, eligibility of agricultural and domestic workers for Social Security, and voters registration drives. What influences caused a stirring of this degree in Black people?

We believe in Messenger Elijah Muhammad, implementation of the aims and purposes set out by Master Fard Muhammad, the message of black love and solidarity was the thing that caused this uptick in activism among Black people at that time, alerting law enforcement agencies in the process.

In 1942, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, was again arrested in Washington, D.C., by the F.B.I. for not registering for the draft and refusing on the grounds that he was a Muslim and would not take part in war on the side of the white race. Being the age of 45 at the time he was not according to law required to register. His detainment was also to prevent him from influencing Black people against joining America's prosecution of its war efforts at that time.

Yet it is clear that his activity level among Black people more than confirm that he too had attracted the concerns of the authorities at that time in the same way as did his teacher. An argument could be made that the rising activism at the time laid the groundwork for the Civil Rights Movement in the 1950s and 1960s. However, we see it from a different angle. We believe that the Government sponsored support given to the 'Civil Movement' was done as a countermeasure to thwart the aims and purposes as was set out by Master Fard Muhammad, for Black people; which was independence, freedom, justice and equality, given us through Messenger Elijah Muhammad.

From 1942 onward it wasn't too long that America saw another Temple of Islam, opened here and another over there eventually spreading all across America. A Muslim school here, a Muslim school there. Then up comes small stores and businesses here and there, land purchases. A national news source Muhammad Speaks Newspapers, was created and sold throughout Black communities all across America.

The Muslim influences are taking hold in the spirit of Black people, who are inculcated with the feeling that they had something they could to call their own. A sense of pride and self-worth was astride their shoulders. The success of the Muslim's, has an impact on them. Soon came the purchases of livestock, farm animals as assets for market and trade. The Muslim's setting up International trade and business deals, for the benefit of all Black people, in realization of the spirit in

the heart of the Honorable Marcus Mosiah Garvey for us. We as a people was on the rise in a real sense.

Where the spirit of the Muslim's was unity of Black people everywhere, black pride, self-love and self-respect; accruing the good things in life, homes, friendship in all walks of life; doing right; freedom justice, and equality; and having something that we could call our own. You would think that the Government of the United States of America, carrying the burden of near 20 to 30 million Black people, in addition to their own, would support the efforts of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, who literally was lifting Black people up to a place of prominence and success like never before.

The Caucasian race in America had so terribly robbed and spoiled the minds and bodies of Black people, that in reality Messenger Elijah Muhammad, was also helping the Caucasian race by relieving a burden off their shoulders that they themselves created. There has been nothing done among or with Black people in America, by the U.S. Government, socially or politically to better our condition more successfully than that which was done by the Muslims and the leadership of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad.

But no, the Government of America, sent in their law enforcement agencies and agents to destroy the little budding Lost Found Nation of Islam.⁹ Rivaling it by taking advantage of an opportunity and heroic stand of a little beautiful Black lady, by the name of Rosa Parks, when she refused to give up her sit on a bus. Contrary to many it was the courageous act of Rosa Parks, which sparked what became known as the 'civil rights' movement of the 1950s and 1960s.

Later, when the eloquent and Honorable Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr, was called to the scene by other political forces. The American Government saw in him an opportunity to maneuver a voice that they could attach the narrative of 'integration' to going against 'segregation.' Everyone knows that the core nature of white society and social order have been whites and blacks, separate and unequal.

So, they went up against Messenger Elijah Muhammad, and promoted Dr. King, using his voice as a countermeasure to the works of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, thereby going up against the progress being made for all Black people in America.

Why would the Government of America do this? Well because they saw too as did many of our people, the budding growth of life and spiritual energy stirring and breaking out in practically every Black person, Black home and Black communities

from coast to coast all across America. A frightening sight for their eyes to behold to say the least.

Furthermore, they saw Messenger Elijah Muhammad, literally taking Black folks right out of their collective hands so they reasoned and plotted with a message of 'integration' that they could bring Black people back over to them and they did. Which looking in retrospect we took some heavy losses in doing so, including the tragic assassination of the Honorable Dr. Martin Luther King.

This is how we should understand in a real-life sense how the knowledge, teachings and guidance of Master Fard Muhammad, transmitted into the mind of Messenger Elijah Muhammad, gave life to our people. And at the same time the impact of it drew the attention of the American Government.

He was the Last Messenger of Allah, and the Spiritual Mother of us all.

In closing. It is with a sense of sadness that Black people in America have bought into the American Government's propaganda machine and cannot grasp the importance of the work ethic and history of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. And can't see the great benefits of what he did in an economic, social, moral, and political sense.

Beginning with his stance with the teachers when he opened up schools to teach our young children, in a moral sense, and also his refusal to fight in wars on the side of the Caucasian people who for as long as we know stood in the way of Black people progressing in any way. To his leadership in economic endeavors and leading the way in establishing an economic foundation across the board to sustain us as a people. And in a political sense his teachings to us to seek reparations and independence for Black people and challenging the injustices of a government who allegedly promises this to all in its society.¹⁰ Yet he's the one least spoken of by so many of the same Black people that he benefitted. Its' sad.¹¹

An irony to all of this is that Messenger Elijah Muhammad, tried to tell us that this was the plan of those who opposed our rise and that they would come after him in this way attempting to thwart the aims and purposes laid down for our success as a people, by referencing himself as the Spiritual Woman of Revelation. But we were to caught up and snagged by ignorance and have yet to understand.

Did he know all of this would happen? Yes, he did and told us so. But again, many have not grasped his astute revolutionary mind and awesome vision. Which presents a salient point that many have casually brushed aside for various reasons,
